Practical and important information

BEFORE THE JOURNEY

- **LUGGAGE**
For the journey we recommend max. one sports bag per person, a small backpack (with personal valuables, toiletry, etc.)
- **TOILET BAG**
Remember to pack toiletry in your handbag and not your suitcase. It will be a good idea to bring a small pillow and a blanket for the bus trip.
- **BED LINEN AND TOWELS**
Remember to bring your own bed linen. In case you don't bring your own, you can rent this at the following cost. Bed linen: 11,00 € double set Bed linen: 8,00 € single set Towels: 4,00 € pr. towel
NB: Some of the beds are made with a big double quilt.
- **INSURANCE**
We hope that you will never come in need of an insurance, but nevertheless we kindly ask you to check all your insurances up front, in order to be prepared for need (Have the blue EU-insurance card).
- **LEGITIMATION**
Always remember to bring your passport, blue EU-insurance card and possibly valid visum.
- **BALLS/COVERVESTS**
We recommend all teams bringing their own footballs as well as covervests. Don't forget to bring the right size of footballs and to mark all your equipment with your club logo.
- **CURRENCY**

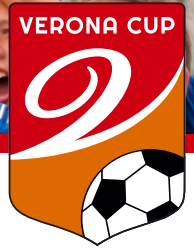
DURING THE STAY

- **CHECK-IN**
For buses with different teams travelling together, there need to be one person for each team having the responsibility for check-ins. For buses with teams from same club, there need to be one person having the responsibility for checking in all teams in the bus.
- The person of contact needs to pay € 100,- in deposit for each unit (mobile home/bungalow/apartment) booking. So if you have booked 7 mobile homes, you need to pay € 700,- in deposit. It is important that you put the correct amount of money in the envelope to the staff at Bella Italia. You will get a receipt for the paid deposit, and deposit will naturally be refunded on departure day when/if the accommodation is returned to the same condition as it was taken over.
 - The person of contact needs to bring the attached document "Registration form" filled with: surname, first name, Place of Birth and Date of Birth of all players.
 - Person of contact needs to bring 1 passport (e.g. private one) for registration of the group.
 - Passports can be picked up at the reception at Bella Italia the day after arrival.
- **KEYS FOR ACCOMMODATION**
Keys and maps for the camping area showing where you are staying will be giving at check-in at the parking lot of Gardaland (only Gardaland visitors). The staff from Bella Italia will give it to you. Keys and other personal belongings are being locked in the bus while the group is in Gardaland. For groups not going to Gardaland, check-in takes place at the reception at Camping Bella Italia.
- **GARDALAND**
On Sundays there is access to Gardaland (for those who bought a ticket). Read more about Gardaland during Sunday's day program on page 11.
- **TICKETS TO GARDALAND**
You will receive your tickets by arrival at Gardaland.
- **PESCHIERA / NOT PARTICIPATING AT GARDALAND**
Sunday the 13.10.2019. Arrival at Gardaland. For those clubs that do not have booked tickets to Gardaland, drive directly to Camping Bella Italia.
- - **BUSTRANSFERS/TRANSPORT** For those who have booked the tournament incl. transport, there will be transport from Camping Bella Italia to the pitches (to and from). The tours take approx. 5-20 min (depending on traffic).

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

From the port of Peschiera you will find regular boat trips to towns along Lake Garda, including Lazise and Garda. Peschiera Station is located on the Milan - Venice route, giving you plenty of opportunities to jump on the train to Verona.

- **TIMETABLE**
Please notice, that you and your club are responsible for your own time table according to check out, meetings, departure, kick off etc. (see matchprogram)
- **CHANGING**
You will find only a few dressing rooms and bathing facilities at the pitches. We recommend that

you change for the game at camping Bella Italia in the morning before the first matches. In case you decide not to change at the fields, please remember bringing a jogging suit and sandals. It is not allowed entering the bus in dirty football clothes.

- **WARM UP**

There is not much space at the pitches for warming up, therefore please show consideration to the matches going on.

- **WATER FOR THE MATCHES**

You are responsible for bringing your own water to the matches. You can buy water in 2 l bottles for about 0,60 € per bottle. - **FINALS** We hope to be seeing all teams at the final matches in order to create the right atmosphere.

- **FIRST AID**

First aid is always available at the pitches. We recommend, though, that you bring your own first aid kit as well (ice, spray, bandages etc.)

- **LOST PROPERTY/THEFT**

Don't leave clothes, bags and valuables unattended in the locker rooms. Always bring your bags and valuables with you to the pitches.

- **LAUNDRY**

At Camping Bella Italia you will find a launderette.

- **CUPS**

All winners and runners-up will receive a cup as well as medals - gold and silver (max. 20 medals per team). The same goes for A and B finals. Simultaneously we will be announcing the "Best Player of the Match" in each category. Every winner of this prize will receive a jogging suit from HUMMEL.

The prize ceremony will take place after each final match; and the announcement of "Best Player of the Match" will take place at the stage of Camping Bella Italia just before the disco party..

- **MEAL SCHEDULES**

When arriving at Gardaland you will get an information sheet showing the time schedule for your teams' meals and in which restaurant at Camping Bella Italia you are having dinner.

- **CATERING DURING VERONA CUP**

There is water for the evening meals. Other beverages juice / soda / beer / wine etc. are at your own expense.

- **BETWEEN MEALS / SNACKS**

There will be the opportunity to buy drinks, sandwiches, snacks, etc. at the pitches.

- **MEALS**

All meals (breakfast and dinner) will be served in the restaurants at Camping Bella Italia. Water is included at dinnertime. Other drinks are at your own expense.

- **AWARD SHOW**

On wednesday the 16.10.2019 Camping Bella Italia you will have the opportunity to participate in the big Award Show and farewell disco party (non-alcoholic) The festivities will start at 21.00 and expected finished at 23.30.

Tournament Rules Verona Cup 2019

Verona Cup is an international youth tournament for boys and girls aged 10-19 years. In all age categories, the tournament begins in pool matches, after which the tournament goes to knock out matches, meaning each team is guaranteed more games in the tournament. In addition, several teams can move on from the pools, as the Verona Cup both contain an A and B tournament and its finals. In all A and B finals there are players Man of the Match awards, and free tickets for next year's Verona Cup.

For the Verona Cup it is possible to participate with 5-, 8-, and 11-men's teams, depending on age category. However, for certain age categories, it is possible to choose between playing 8- and 11-man tournaments, as shown in the tables below. In the 11 men's matches, 2 x 20 minutes are played, and in 5- and 8-game matches 2 x 15 minutes are played.

In all age categories, both boys and girls, it is possible to use 2 age dispensations per match that can be up to a year older.

§ 1 – Organization

The Verona Cup is organized by SportConcept in collaboration with Costantino Falsirolì.

§ 3 – Club participants

It is not allowed to insert players from other clubs during the matches. You can only use players from your own club. If a dispensation is granted for this rule, the player during the tournament can only play for the team for which the dispensation is granted.

§ 4 – Participant list

Before the tournament start, a complete team list (full name and date of birth) is handed to the tournament secretariat. The participant list is final and thus changes from the participant lists are not allowed. Additionally, it is not allowed for any players to play for more than one team during the tournament.

§ 5 – Replacement of players

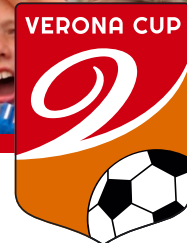
In the 11: 11 categories it is allowed to use 16 players per. match in the 8: 8 categories it is allowed to use 13 players per. match, and in the 5: 5 categories it is allowed to use 10 players per. match. That is, 5 replacement players per. match in all categories. Replacements can only take place by gamestop. A replaced player can be used as substitute again in the same match.

§ 6 – OFFSIDE

In all 8-á-side & 5-á-side categories, there is NO offside rule.

§ 7 – CORNER KICK 8:8 & 5:5

In alle the 8-á-side and 5-á-side categories, the corner kick will be taken in the corner where sideline and goalline meets. The opponent must have minimum 7m distance to the spot of the corner kick. In the categories U12, U11 & U10 will be taken on a spot between sideline and the goal area.

§ 8 CLASSIFICATION

There are 3 points for victory, 1 point for draw and 0 points for lost match.

In case of teams being level on points, the following applies to decide placings:

- Result of match between teams
- Goal difference
- Most goals scored
- Penalty shootout

§ 9 – RESULTS

After each match, the coach (or team leader) from each team must turn to the referee to sign the match card

If you forget or refuse to sign the match card, you will automatically lose the match 0-3

§ 10 – PENALTY SHOOTOUTS

In case of a draw in crucial matches (finals) the decision takes place in the form of a penalty shootout. Initially 5 players from each team. If the position is still equal, 1 penalty per team (sudden death) until the winner is found.

§ 11 – CLUB UNIFORMS

In case of uniform wear / color or if the referee estimates that the colors of the two team jerseys are too similar, the first team in the tournament plan must change jerseys.

§ 10 – JUDGES

All matches are led by referees under the Danish Football Union. Each team will be asked to provide a linesman for all initial pool matches. All finals are led by referees and assistants under the Danish Football Union.

§ 11 – CONTROL

One of the judges under the Danish Football Union is appointed as official inspector. In case of protests, his assessment of the protest is valid. Decisions from here can not be appealed.

§ 12 – PROTEST

No protests against court orders may be submitted. Protests for other reasons must be submitted to the tournament secretariat immediately and no later than 10 minutes after the game, which deals with the protest. The opposing team must have a copy of the protest. Submission of protests for free – but lost protest, deducted from the team 2 points.

§ 13 – DISCIPLINE

One yellow card automatically gives 5 min's expulsion. 2 yellow cards or 1 red card in the same match will automatically be banned in the following match. In particularly coarse cases, however, the controlling authority (see § 11) may further increase the penalty.

§ 14 – CANCELLATION OF MATCHES

Unless the official inspector (see § 11) has given another commitment, a referee may cancel a match:

- If a team without valid reason is late or absent from a match.
- If a team has used a non-playable player.
- If the referee estimates that some player/coach/leader/team behavior is so bad that the match can not be carried out in a friendly manner
- If the referee feels threatened by one or more players/coaches/leaders.

§ 15 – RESPONSIBILITY

All teams must be accompanied by an adult (over 18 years). Their full name, address and age must be shown in the participant list that is handed to the tournament secretariat before the tournament start (see section 4). He/she is at all times responsible for the players' behavior throughout the tournament – both on and off the pitch.

§ 16 – BAD BEHAVIOR

All reports regarding Individual player / team bad behavior is passed to the National Football Association – in this case, DBU.

§ 17 – INSURANCE

All participating teams are responsible for ensuring that all their players are insured. Organizers and SportConcept International is not responsible in case of damage, lost property, theft of personal belongings, guards and the like. This also applies to damages incurred in connection with the tournament.

§ 18 – GENERAL

For cases not mentioned in this regulation, the rules of the National Federation apply – in this case, the DBU.
